2026 Fee Schedule

Fees payable before enrolment

Registration Fee	An \$80 non-refundable registration fee per student is payable at the time of lodging an application form via the online enrolment portal.
Enrolment Fee	A \$995 per student non-refundable enrolment fee is payable at time of acceptance of an offer of a place. This amount is not deducted from the annual fee.

Fees payable after enrolment

Tuition Fees	The College charges a Tuition Fee which are invoiced in January each year and are paid through the methods of payment included in this fee schedule.
Year Levy	The year levy includes subject resources (K-6), consumables, technology levy, camps, single day excursions and their related costs and miscellaneous administrative costs associated with education. The levy does not include recreational sport costs, extracurricular programs, Duke of Edinburgh scheme expeditions', elective excursions and missions.
Capital Levy	The capital levy of \$1,370 per family supports the ongoing development of the College, including the maintenance of infrastructure and grounds. To support the Building Project, on average, an additional 1.5% will be applied to families with students in Preparatory to Year 10, as these year groups will benefit most from the new facilities. Families with students in Year 11 and Year 12 in 2026, and with no younger siblings enrolled, will only pay the capital levy of \$1,370 per family.

Upfront Payment

Families who pay the total annual fee by 27 February 2026 will receive a 2.5% early payment discount.

Sibling Discount

A concession applies to tuition fees only where two or more members of the immediate family concurrently attend the College and no other concession, such as a scholarship, applies. The sibling discount does not apply to Preparatory students.

The Sibling Discount is as follows:

Methods of Payment

BPAY: An unique reference number for BPAY payments is found at the bottom left-hand corner of the Fee Statement.

Direct Debit: The College prefers Direct Debit payments due to high merchant fees on credit cards. [Direct Debit Form](#)

EFT and Direct Deposit: Payments can be made by EFT or deposited into Mount Annan Christian College bank account (**BSB:** 032 717 **Account:** 186566). Please use your Family number and Family name as reference.

Phone or in person: The College accepts payment over the phone by Credit Card. Please call 4634 7474 and select 3 for Finance and then 1 for School Fees or in person by card or in cash at the College Reception. Please note that the College does not accept American Express cards.

Fee Policy

Parents and carers who enrol a student at Mount Annan Christian College are responsible for paying all fees charged by the College during the term of that enrolment. Families who choose to pay their annual fees via weekly, fortnightly, or monthly instalments must ensure that at least 25% of the annual fee is paid each term, and that the full annual fee is paid by end of the school year.

From 2026 onwards, extra-curricular activities, music tuition, College Sport (if applicable), and bus charges must be paid at the time of booking each term, through Clipboard or Roll Call App, and will not be included in fee statements.

The College reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions without written notice. Please refer to the College's Payment Options and Collection Policy for additional information.

Withdrawal of a Student

A minimum of ten full term weeks' notice is required for withdrawal. Notice must be provided in writing to the College's Community Engagement Officer using the College Withdrawal Form. If insufficient notice is given, one term's tuition fee will be payable in lieu of notice.
